

The Shelby City Health Department is an Ohio Department of Health approved provider/proctor of the Level One and Level Two Certification in Food Protection training programs. These courses meet the national, state, and local standards for food service employees.

Level 1

All food operations, including license risk level 1, 2, 3, and 4, are required to have at least one person-in-charge per shift certified in Level One Food Protection. Some operations that opened prior to March 1, 2010 are not required, but encouraged, to have one person in charge per shift certified in Level One Food Protection. All entry level food workers would benefit from this training.

Course will cover: Food source, personal hygiene and handwashing, cross contamination, cleaning/sanitizing of equipment and utensils, and proper cooking, cooling, and holding of food.

Level 2

All food operations that have a license risk level 3 or 4 are required to have at least one employee that has supervisory and management responsibility and the authority to direct and control food preparation and service certified in Level Two Food Protection by March 1, 2017.

Course will cover: Food source, personal hygiene, cross contamination, cleaning/sanitizing of equipment and utensils, and proper cooking, cooling, and holding of food microbiology, foodborne illness, facility design and construction, and active managerial control.
